reformed church the doctrine of the ministry is expounded and some controversial questions considered including questions about the nature of the eldership the final chapter reviews the whole conception of the church as the body of christ macgregor concludes that the reformed doctrine of the church is based soundly on scripture and the classic definitions of the person of christ and that the only ground for unity in the church is christ himself the church exists where the word is preached and the sacraments are celebrated and where it calls men to discipline and to service scholarly footnotes are given on almost every page and two appendices are provided one contains passages in latin illustrating the teaching of st augustine on christ as the head and the church as the body the other contains extracts in latin french and english from ten confessional documents beginning with the augsburg confession 1530 and extending to the westminster confession 1647 there is also an extended bibliography and a topical index this book is an excellent resource for ministers teachers and students alike
