contains over five hundred fifty illustrated photographs of stetsons boots spurs saddles chaps and other trappings of the american western cowboy and cowgirl and traces the history of the cowboy from the cattle trails of the old west to the wild west shows and rodeos

most of the gamblers of the old west got their start and reputations by working the circuit of the mississippi river boats the railhead cattle towns of kansas or the boomtowns that popped up around gold or silver mining the gunfighter ben thompson got his start by running the bull s head

saloon with partner phil coe in ellsworth kansas ben s friend bat masterson also started his career in the cattle towns of texas and kansas in general these legendary gamblers were known as legitimate or that they played a fair game without cheating truth be told all of them knew the methods employed by the sharps to clean the pockets of the other players at the table they had to know these tricks in order to spot a cheater at their table did they ever use any of these advantages to increase their odds probably so but the public s perception of these men was that they ran a square game hip pocket history of the old west series this compact book that gives concise accounts of odd or little known facets of the american west historically accurate but told in an easy to read format with just a twist of humor informative yet entertaining the hip pocket history series provides little nuggets without having to wade through a 400 page book of dry academic ostentatiousness

in an elaborately documented day by day format the old west meticulously records every incident that shaped the frontier from the years 1848 to 1890 whether it s a gold discovery an advance in transcontinental travel or a series of racial skirmishes each chronological entry furnishes the reader with a quick fascinating summary this extraordinary reference condenses and organizes decades of history and lore that must otherwise be laboriously hunted down in newspaper records and secondary sources

a collection of over 150 vignettes from the journals and diaries of people who lived or traveled in the old west these accounts begin with the sixteenth century collisions between the spaniards and the indians and conclude with black elk s mournful description of the battle of wounded knee in 1890 storytellers include explorers missionaries india leaders a poet an artist and a future president

a child of the frontier walter stanley campbell best known as stanley vestal was a great preserver of the romance and reality of america s west vestal was a novelist biographer historian master teacher of writers a plainsman in love with the indian way of life artillery captain rhodes scholar and above all an exhaustive researcher dust jacket

this book is about the real old west the research presented here comes from what i ve found during my more than forty five years of researching american history but especially what i ve learned in regards to the other side of the myths and legends of the old west in 2010 i started a blog the american cowboy chronicles to share what i ve learned and celebrate the virtues of america my articles on the old west have never been meant to dispel the myths or attack legends but to simply explain what i ve found after taking a hard look an honest look an objective look at the evidence that s available since evidence proves or disproves what we ve all been told about the old west by hollywood and writers who are not objective researchers this is my attempt at taking a fresh look at wyatt earp tom horn and others but mostly this book is about why the american cowboy became america s quintessential role model this book looks at why the american cowboy represents american toughness independence and resilience to the rest of the world

during the 1870s and 1880s cowboy and drifter frank clifford s restless spirit led him all over the southwest crossing the paths of many of the era s most notorious characters most notably clay allison and billy the kid more than just an entertaining and informative narrative of his wild west adventures clifford s memoir also paints a picture of how ranchers and ordinary folk lived worked and stayed alive during those tumultuous years written in 1940 and edited and annotated by frederick nolan deep trails in the old west is likely one of the last eyewitness histories of the old west ever to be discovered

the old west may have faded from living memory but the actual locations where the robberies and shoot outs took place can still be found over one hundred years later in the pages of on the trail of the old west then and now we glimpse the past through contemporary newspaper reports illustrated with comparison then and now photographs here are towns like dodge city and tombstone and the stories of the clashes between lawmen and the badmen with grim details of lawlessness violence and harsh frontier justice meted out by vigilante committees to recall a timeless era of american history the wild west
