twenties in which realistic rather than romantic approaches to the legends prevailed and scholarship began to influence arthurian retellings the lost generation novelists use of arthurian motifs especially those related to the wasteland and fisher king themes that they found in eliot's waste land and the re interpretations of arthurian tradition in the fiction of steinbeck whose acts of king arthur was the culmination of a lifelong interest and of other contemporary writers like walker Percy Thomas Berger Bobbie Ann Mason Donald Barthelme and John Updike each of whom adapted the legends to distinctly modern american concerns a concluding chapter analyzes arthurian themes in american popular fiction and film and demonstrates the extent to which the arthurian tradition has influenced american popular culture from commercial products to advertising from toys and games to comic books and television shows from art to architecture a comprehensive bibliography offers the most extensive listing ever assembled of primary and secondary sources of american arthuriana
