una colección de cuentos de los clásicos de la literatura hispanoamericana un cuento por país un total de 19 cuentos

con más de 30 mil ejemplares vendidos y una fama que ha trascendido con mucho las esferas académicas the oxford book of latin american short stories es considerada una obra de referencia para conocer y entender el fenómeno del cuento latinoamericano en estas relecturas roberto gonzález echevarría presenta por primera vez en español la introducción de su icónica obra la que acompaña de dos ensayos sobre cuentos latinoamericanos uno de borges y otro de carpentier que son una muestra de su aproximación al género y de su estilo de crítica el caudal de la tradición cuentística en américa latina desmiente a quienes consideran que el subdesarrollo económico y la inestabilidad política son idénticos a la pobreza artística algunos de los escritores mencionados se encuentran entre los mejores del mundo moderno y han ejercido influencia en las literaturas de las áreas más desarrolladas del orbe el oxford book of latin american short stories es una excelente colección brillantemente editada por roberto gonzález echevarría sus presentaciones son esclarecedoras e informativas las historias mismas hispanoamericanas o brasileñas son siempre de alto mérito estético cubriendo toda la gama desde borges a arenas harold bloom

durante el siglo xx la creación circulación y recepción de cuentos tuvo un espacio singular en la literatura hispanoamericana a lo largo de ese siglo se cimentó una tradición de practicantes teóricos del cuento esto es escritores que produjeron no solo cuentos sino también reflexiones sobre su quehacer este libro abre una mirada amplia sobre las cuestiones esenciales de esta especie literaria para luego analizar la construcción de una teoría del cuento por parte de jorge luis borges julio cortázar y juan José Arreola entre 1935 y 1969 modelos y prácticas en el cuento hispanoamericano arreola borges cortázar estudia la obra de estos escritores en conjunto por primera vez a partir de una serie de coincidencias y afinidades que fundamentan un modelo un abc surgido de las variaciones del sistema de doble historia o doble orden con el que se pueden leer y analizar sus cuentos

esta selección de relatos breves constituye una muestra de la mejor narrativa hispanoamericana del siglo xx decálogo del perfecto cuentista y la insolación de quiroga el espejo y la máscara y emma zunz de borges la noche boca arriba y no se le culpe a nadie de cortázar es que somos muy pobres y luvina de rulfo el ahogado más hermoso del mundo de garcía Márquez parábola del trueque de arreola familia iriarte de benedetti el posible baldi de onetti el eclipse de monterroso la carne de piñera y feliz viaje hermano antonio de bryce echenique
