Anyone who has done a serious study of the gospel of John and then sought to compare that gospel with Matthew Mark and Luke found that they were immediately confronted with many differences over the years I have studied all the gospels and this has increased my interest in how others were handling these differences both in their teaching and in their sermons to my surprise most of the people consulted have never made an honest effort to have some answer for these differences furthermore I have not been able to locate any books that speak to the one problem of these differences

readers of the new testament since before the bible was canonized how does one reconcile the different accounts of jesus s life given by the four gospels today the most highly publicized answer to this question is the one offered by john dominic crossan and the jesus seminar who seek to reconcile the differences among the gospels by designating some events and statements in the gospels historically true and others false there are lots of other ways to explore the synoptic problem however and dungan provides a clear and lively history of the strategies employed by origen augustine erasmus spinoza locke and others dungan s method is to break the synoptic problem down into its corollary questions which gospels should be considered in the debate which text of each gospel should be considered and how should one read the bible in general and the gospels in particular dungan s interest in these questions is not merely literary he also delves into the political and economic agendas that have influenced biblical interpretation in this regard the most interesting and original connection he makes is to explain the relationship between the rise of the modern historical critical method of reading scripture asking who wrote the books of the bible when how and for whom and the creation and maintenance of political democracy and furthermore the ways in which fundamentalist literal readings of scripture serve the same goal dungan s own investment in debates on the synoptic problem is shot through with an appealing humility about the stakes of the debate at its deepest level the synoptic problem is not a scientific problem he writes t he quest for the correct solution to the synoptic problem like the church s quest for the correct canon of the gospels and the correct text of the gospels and the correct way to interpret the gospels is a vital aspect of the church s perennial quest for the word of life

a compelling reappraisal of the relationships between the canonical gospels biblical scholars have long debated the synoptic problem and the literary relationship between the gospel of john and the synoptics during the twentieth century the consensus shifted decisively to the two source hypothesis for the synoptic problem along with the view that john s gospel was independent of the synoptics in recent decades all consensus has dissolved yet these questions retain currency and significance james w barker takes up these questions and reappraises the evidence drawing on his expertise in ancient compositional practices he makes a persuasive case for a snowballing trajectory whereby each canonical gospel drew upon other canonical gospels thus mark was written first matthew draws on mark luke draws on mark and matthew and the last of the four john is dependent on all three synoptics and was meant to be read alongside them this judicious and ambitious

the book of psalms is one of the most frequently cited books in the new testament the synoptic evangelists seem to read the psalms not primarily as prayers but as prophecies of the future they discovered in its language prophecies concerning the life and ministry of jesus and attempted to show how jesus life was prefigured in the psalms samuel subramanian examines the topic within the broader use of the old testament in the new testament that of the prophetic reading of the psalms in the synoptic gospels and in the context of second temple judaism although others have treated individual psalm quotations as prophecy my work is the first to examine all of the psalm quotations within the synoptic gospels in this light and the first to demonstrate that these excerpts were used prophetically in some cases these psalm quotations were used by the synoptic evangelists in a manner that is thought to fulfill a prophecy from or about jesus within the gospel narratives even though this particular use of the psalms by the synoptic evangelists has not been widely recognized previously this study shows how similar exegetical techniques of looking for prophecies in the psalms was practiced by non christian jews of the period

does the resolute defense of their beliefs prove that the christian proto communities earliest documents about jesus life did not have the discrepancies contradictions and conflicts which exegetes argue existed in the four gospels their presence has divided the gospels into the synoptics and john declared by most contemporary exegetes to be originally greek in their composition geis claims that the various differences in synoptic accounts can be explained by the evidence that reveals they were originally whole or in part hebrew documents that were later translated into greek the texts lexically provide a basis for
