consequences for the soul the book returns to philosophy in the final part plumbing several platonic dialogues the republic cleitophon hipparchus phaedrus euthyphro and symposium to understand the soul s imperfection in relation to law justice tyranny eros the gods and philosophy itself davis concludes with plato s presentation of the soul of socrates as self aware and nontragic even if it is necessarily alienated and divided against itself the soul of the greeks thus begins with the imperfect soul as it is manifested in achilles heroic but tragic longing and concludes with its nontragic and fuller philosophic expression in the soul of socrates but far from being a historical survey it is instead a brilliant meditation on what lies at the heart of being human
