beginning with number 41 1979 the university of texas press became the publisher of the most comprehensive annual bibliography in latin american studies compiled by the hispanic division of the library of congress and annotated by a corps of more than 140 specialists in various disciplines the handbook alternates from year to year between social sciences and humanities the handbook annotates works on mexico central america the caribbean and the guianas spanish
