this collection of essays interrogates the repositioning of africa and its diasporas in the unfolding disruptive transformations of the early twenty first century it is divided into five parts focusing on america s racial dysfunctions navigating global turbulence africa s

political dramas the continent's persistent mythologisation and disruptions in higher education it closes with tributes to two towering african public intellectuals ali mazrui and thandika mkandawire who have since joined the ancestors

different ways because of their gender they all participated in the conflict in various ways consequently the efforts at peace building are given a gendered analysis in terms of what has happened to women and girls in the demobilization and rehabilitation period including an excellent analysis of land reform in rwanda and how that affects women and members of a certain ethnic group that are often overlooked in the examination of the 1994 genocide this book provides a very good contribution to the literature on conflict and post conflict african countries because of its depth and the vast topics it embraces it provides an analysis of the internal and external actors the role of gender in post conflict decision making and it provides the voices of ordinary africans who were affected by the conflict and who are determined to live productive lives
